SUBJECT: SEARCH Survey Results

In April of 2007 SEARCH performed a national survey of US state's and territories' criminal justice and non-criminal justice (i.e. civil and referred to as such from this point forth) fingerprint criminal history record checks done in 2006. 43 states and Puerto Rico responded. Using the data provided by SEARCH and population data from the US Census Bureau a per 100 population ratio was created to rank the respondent states. Below is a summary of the results:

Civil Based Background Checks

Nevada's Average Civil Response time for non electronic submissions in 4th Quarter FY 2006 53.27 days Nevada's Average Civil Response time for non electronic submissions in 3rd Quarter FY 2007 31.28 days Nevada's Average Civil Response Time for Electronic submissions has remained under 2 days for the year.

This survey places Nevada as the highest producer of per population civil fingerprint background checks and 3.5 times higher than the national average.

Summary

The survey shows that Nevada is the leading per person conductor of Civil Fingerprint Based Background Checks for the year 2006. This is impressive as Nevada barely makes up a percentage of the country's population. Also, it should be noted that other than Nevada only 9 other states perform more civil checks than criminal.
