

Emergency Contact Information for Wireless Telecommunications Providers

Pursuant to NRS 707.640, providers of wireless telecommunications services are required to provide to the Department of Public Safety, Records, Communication, and Compliance Division, an emergency contact that can be reached 24x7x365 to assist Nevada law enforcement agencies in responding to a call for emergency services or emergency situations involving the immediate risk of death to a person or serious physical harm to a person. Providers of wireless telecommunications are required to provide emergency contact information to the Department annually and as soon as practicable following any change in emergency contact information. Providers may provide up to three emergency contacts but are not required to do so.
