### **New Features and Capabilities**

#### LEMS

- Provides robust database-search capabilities.
- Provides the ability to use a smart key to run a query or to use a template to open a screen without the use of a mouse.
- Performs the new Railroad Crossing Query (RCQ) for geospatial coordinates, operating company, emergency contact phone numbers, and other details.

#### **NCCIS Portal**

- Provides time savings to users and reduces number of log-ons.
- Offers reliable and easy access to background checks, criminal history, and documentation.
- Supports mobile access to DPS applications.
- Provides access through any web browser through the State's SilverNet connection.



## New Features and Capabilities (continued)

#### **NCJIS/NCIC** Validations

- New solution should take less time to complete validation.
- The goal is for a less-convoluted process.
- Will include all current functionality.

#### Warrants/Wanted Persons

- New design enables entry of multiple warrants without duplicate work, providing increased efficiency.
- All warrants will be saved in the State system, with the option of a copy to be forwarded to NCIC.
- An investigative interest or administrative search will not notify record owners.
- Users can query other participating states for warrants (SWQ).
- Links to help files will be available.



### New Features and Capabilities (continued)

#### **Background Checks**

- National Instant Criminal Background Checks (NICS) Disposition of Firearms background checks will be available to evidence vaults.
- Concealed Carry Weapon (CCW) will be automated with the new system.
- Law enforcement will submit fingerprints for civil purposes, mailed or live scan, with results returned electronically.
