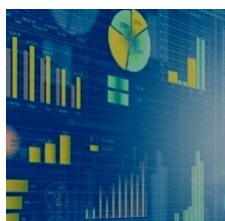
Executive Sponsor News



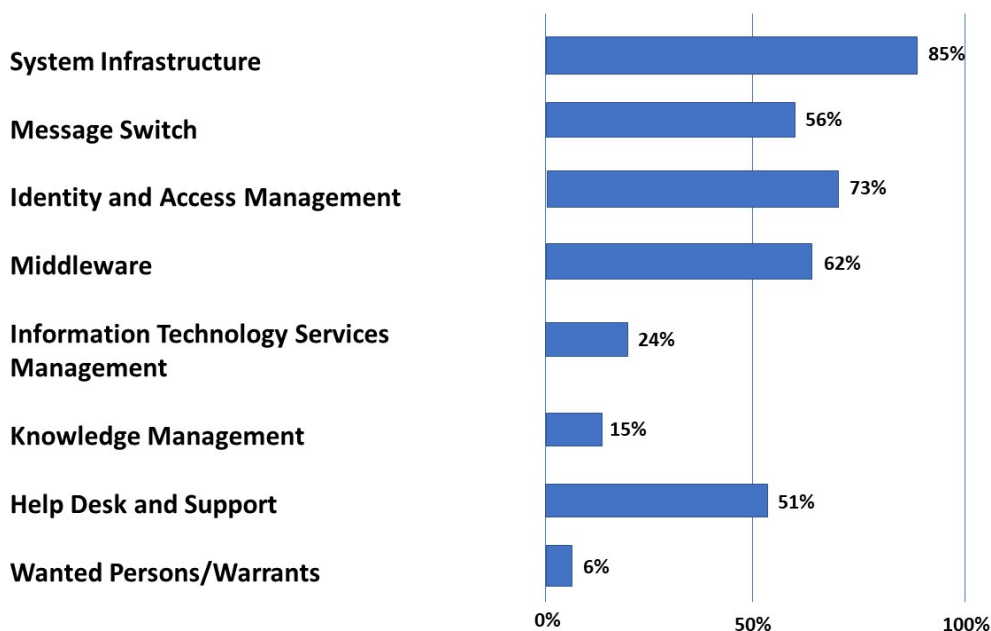

Stakeholder Outreach

The Change Manager has been fully engaged in reaching out to our criminal justice stakeholders for pertinent information needed at this point in the modernization.

We will soon be shifting gears back to our civil stakeholders and will be coordinating another round of meetings with the appointed change ambassadors to prepare for a coming survey.

The Voice of the Customer survey will be delivered in April 2021 to ensure that your business interests are understood. Results of this survey will be studied and delivered to the appropriate RCCD managers for analyzing and prioritizing business process improvement efforts to adequately support the automated system.

To date, we have 240 representatives from a cross section of criminal justice and civil stakeholder organizations signed up as change ambassadors to help facilitate the coming changes.

All preliminary project tasks are going well and on schedule. All infrastructure is in place and connected according to the timeline in preparation for civil application development in the fall.
