The Nevada Criminal Justice Information System (NCJIS) Modernization Program is gearing up for the next phase of solution training and rollout. This modernization effort will replace existing NCJIS applications and add critical system functionality for internal and external users. The rollout of the new solutions will improve the efficiency and effectiveness of public safety operations and provide improved services to the public.

The change ambassador role serves as the main point-of-contact(s) for your agency. More than one change ambassador may be appointed for large organizations. Terminal Agency Coordinators (TACs) and Assistant Terminal Agency Coordinators (ATAC), along with appropriate IT personnel, are encouraged to sign up.

The selected individual(s) should:

- Commit to helping drive communication and comprehension within their agency or sphere of influence.
- Be able to help determine who exactly needs to receive communication, how often they need to receive it, and how best the communication can be delivered.

A change ambassador does not need to be a manager but should ideally have these qualities:

- Understands and can get behind the big picture.
- Drives or can drive communication in their area.
- Knows the system.
- Is recognized as a champion for change or a leader across many ranks.
