


## **Official Go-Live**

#### May 2, 2023 – Go-Live

- Production connections completed are:
  - Interstate Identification Index (III)
  - National Crime Information Center (NCIC)
  - Nlets the International Justice and Public Safety Network
- The NCJIS Modernization Program is rolling out the NCCIS Portal with these systems:
  - NCCIS Identity and Access Management (IAM)
  - Law Enforcement Message Switch (LEMS)
  - eAgent







# **Rollout Schedule**




## **Rollout Schedule**

- Inquiry only agencies
  - Agencies that run queries via the Message Switch to the State files, Nlets, NCIC, DMV, and other authorized files
  - Go-live by groups 1 7 between May and August 2023
- Entry agencies
  - Agencies that enter records into the State and/or NCIC files such as warrants, missing persons, and stolen property records
  - Go-live by groups 1 4 between October and December 2023

Several factors could alter these groupings such as an agency's level of preparedness, status of federating to the NCJIS environment, and most importantly, the method of connection.








### Schedule: Overview and Hard Stops




#### Schedule: Inquiry Agency

# **Agency Preparation**



#### Agency Preparation Ensuring Continuity

- The NCJIS Mod Team is working with agencies individually to prepare, train, and walk them through the migration process.
- Agencies will stay on the current JLink solution until time for transition.
- There will be no disruption in service, and agencies will be given time to prepare.
- Both solutions will continue to work until all agencies are successfully migrated to the new solution.



#### Agency Preparation Countdown to Go-live

2 months prior	Agency 1:1 meetings: Scheduling, checklist, TAC preparation
1 month prior	Training materials and videos
2 weeks prior	Online training and demonstrations
1 week prior	Additional information and assistance



# Foreign Host Update



## Foreign Host Update

- Agencies that have a foreign host (FH) connection or plan to have one will be migrated separately from the NCCIS Portal migration.
- Timelines are dependent on the agency and its CAD/RMS vendor readiness.
- Functionality will remain the same on how users query information.
- Migration must be completed prior to May 15, 2024.
- A checklist was provided to all Administrators, Terminal Agency Coordinators (TACs) and Assistant Agency Terminal Coordinators (ATACs).
- The checklist outlines and describes the steps necessary for agency FH test systems to establish and test connections to the Law Enforcement Message Switch/Justice Exchange (LEMS/JX).

# Federated vs. Not Federated

- Federated. When federated, you will open your browser and go to the NCCIS website. This site will check your Windows credentials from your agency and log you in directly as the user. User accounts are shared by the agency's Active Directory. The TAC only has to update user privileges, not user IDs.
- Not Federated. The path that most agencies will have requires users to open the web browser and log in using their credentials (specific to the portal).
  TACs will have to maintain both user accounts and privileges.
